



# Workshops on Basic Income 2020

Following the recommendation adopted on 23 January 2018 by the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, the ToShare Observatory for Fair Distribution of Wealth has organised a series of workshops on the impact that a universal basic income would have on society and on people's lives, especially aimed at Basque youth.
